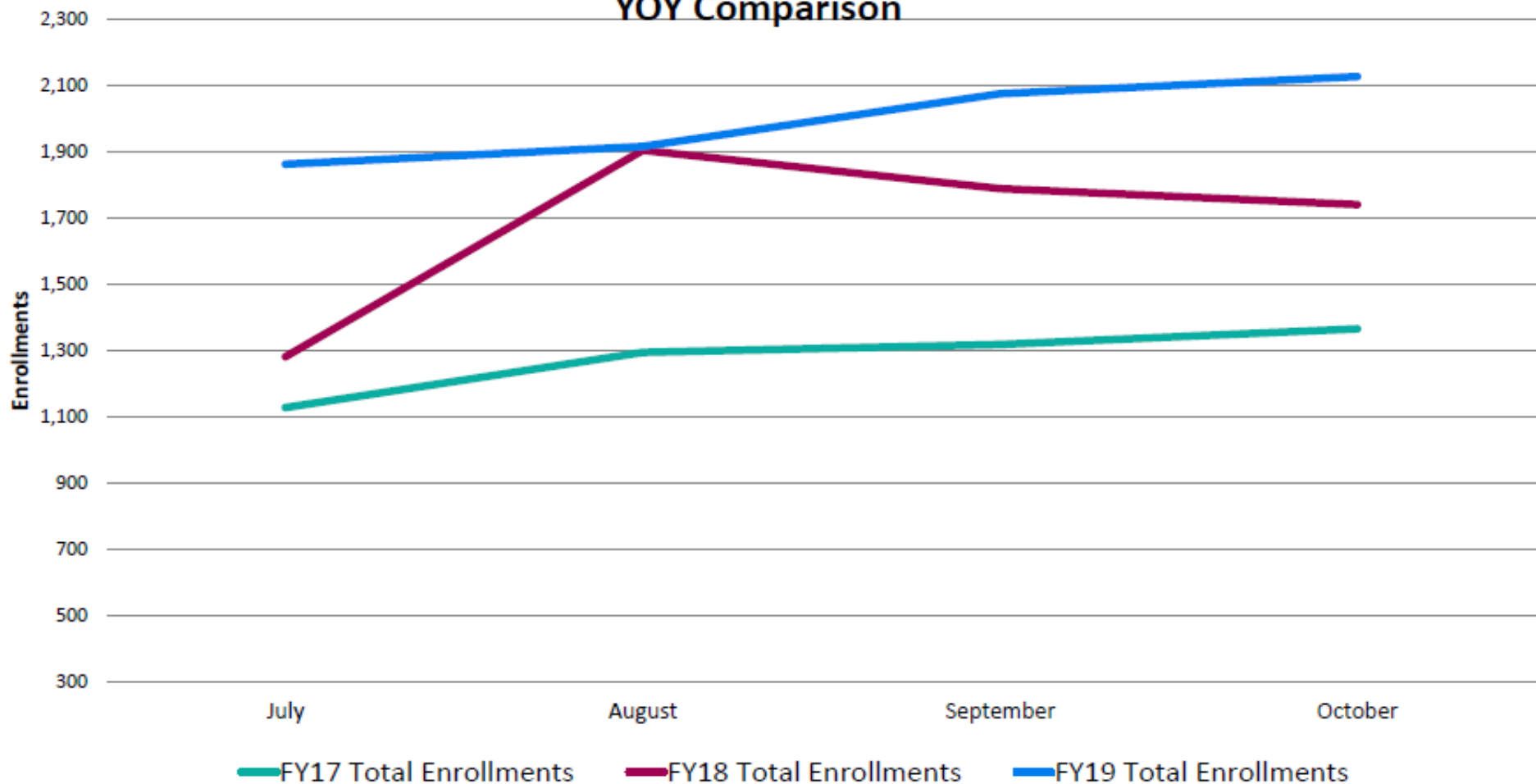

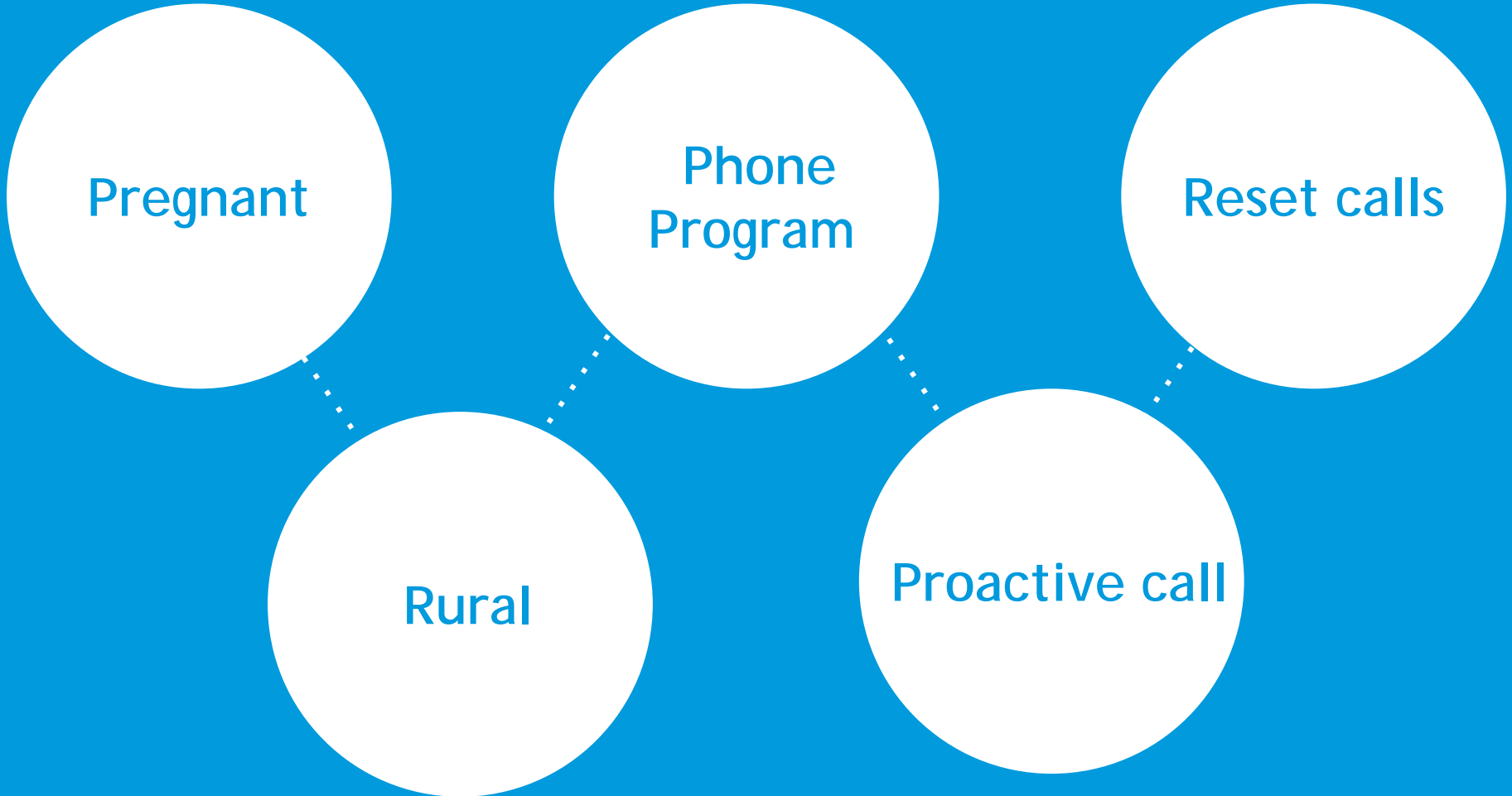

Monthly Statewide Total Enrollments YOY Comparison



The trend in web enrollments is increasing total enrollments to the QuitLine program. FY18 total enrollments were up 7.5% over FY17, and thus far FY19 enrollments are up 18.9% through October.
